**CLEADON All Saints Church**

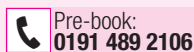
Sunderland Road SR6 7UR

Built originally in 1866, dedicated in 1869. Chancel portraits of the crucified Lord and Risen Christ by Simon Hoare. Stained glass windows by Leonard Evetts. Chapter House recently completed. Award-winning gardens.

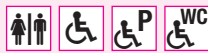

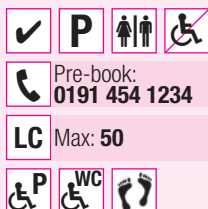


SOUTH SHIELDS St Hilda's Colliery

Nr St Hilda's Industrial Estate, Station Road

2014 is the 175th anniversary of the Hilda's pit disaster which killed 51 people. As a consequence St Hilda's played an important role in developing ventilation, lighting and safety in the mines. Local colliery banners, old photographs and information on local mining heritage will be on display.

SOUTH SHIELDS Westovian Theatre – Open Days

Pier Parade NE33 2JS

Originally an old seaside shelter, it was converted into a small community theatre in 1948. It was used by a number of societies until the Westovians took over the building in 1977. Internally, the original old cast iron columns and fretted iron arch spandrels give touches of visual delight and Victorian character. There is a raked 292-seat auditorium with plush red 1930s tip-up seats that are contained between a run of cast iron columns either side of the auditorium. The coffee bar will be open for refreshments.

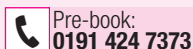


WEST BOLDON St Nicholas Church

Rectory Bank NE36 0QQ

St Nicholas Church was founded in 1220 with strong evidence of Saxon origins. Many features of interest to view including stained glass windows and memorial tablets.

WEST BOLDON West Boldon Lodge Open Day

Newcastle Road, Boldon Colliery NE36 0BQ

The 'Lodge' houses an environmental education facility on a reclaimed industrial site promoting biodiversity. This is an opportunity to explore the varied habitats and try your hand at pond dipping and minibeast hunting. Craft activities also available.

WHITBURN Whitburn Windmill

Mill Lane, Coast Road SR6 7BD

A unique chance to visit this stone tower windmill built in 1796 to replace an earlier wooden wind post mill that was blown down during a storm. Restored in 1992 with cap and sails (not a working mill).
